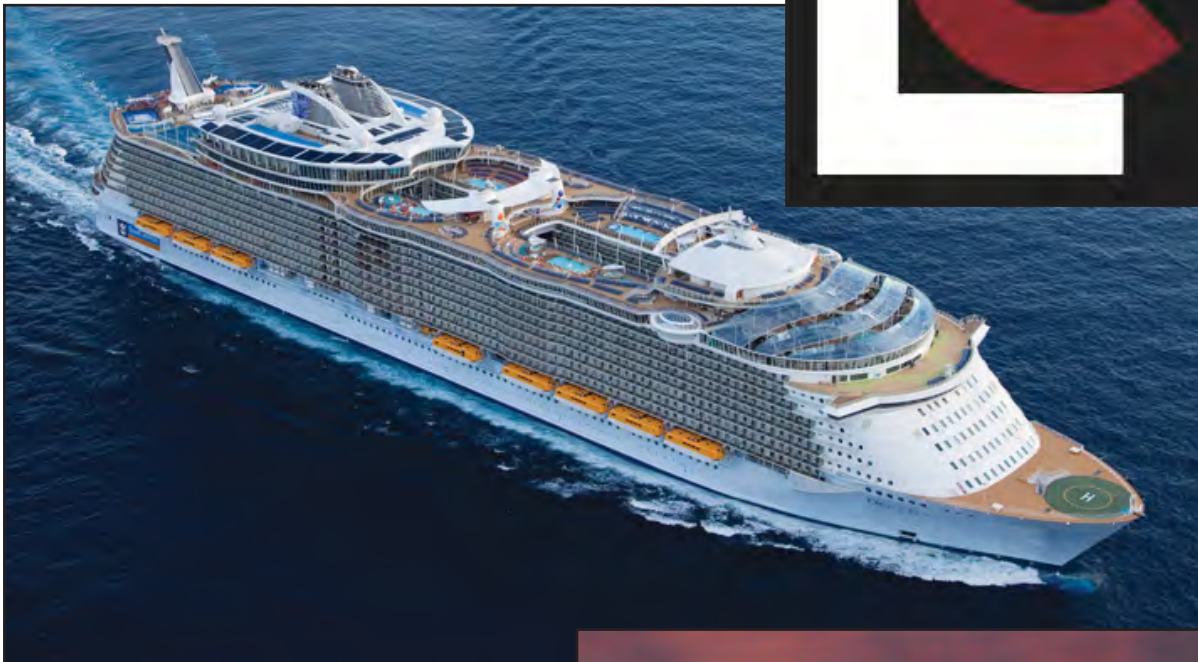

PAYMENT: A deposit of \$300 per person is required at the time of booking. Final payment is due no later than June 20, 2017. PLEASE NOTE THAT FAILURE TO SUBMIT FINAL PAYMENT BY DUE DATE WILL RESULT IN AUTOMATIC CANCELLATION OF YOUR CRUISE BY ROYAL CARIBBEAN INTERNATIONAL. *Enrollment in and payment of deposit constitutes your acceptance of the Terms & Conditions described herein.*

AIRARRANGEMENTS: Airfare is not included. Dehoney Travel will assist in booking flights from your hometown departure city if desired. Contact our office for more information. If booking air with Dehoney Travel, please note that specific air seat requests will be forwarded to the airline on your behalf but are subject to final approval/confirmation by the airline.

GRATUITIES: Cruise gratuities (approximately \$13.50 per person, per day) are not included in the travel rate and will be added to your shipboard account on your behalf.

DINING: Enjoy the convenience and flexibility of My Time Dining. Simply place a reservation for your desired seating time. You can choose a different time each day, so you can fit dinner around the rest of your onshore and onboard plans.

NOT INCLUDED IN CRUISE RATE: Port charges (\$225), government taxes/fees (\$120), gratuities (approximately \$13.50 per person, per day, added to shipboard account); shore excursions; any Royal Caribbean fuel surcharge (up to \$10 per person per day); transfers; transportation between your hometown & Port Canaveral; Travel Protection Plan; meals not listed as included; items of a personal nature.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTATION: Citizens of the United States are strongly urged to have a valid passport for this cruise. However, United States citizens on cruises that begin and end at the same port in the United States may instead use an original government-issued picture ID (i.e. driver's license) AND either an original government-issued birth certificate or original Naturalization Certificate.

CHANGES: A \$100 service fee will be charged for changes made to existing tours within 45 days of departure. Changes of departure date or tour are considered a cancellation and a new booking. The service fee will not be assessed when upgrading cruise accommodations.

CANCELLATION: In event of cancellation, there will be a fee of \$100 for Dehoney Travel, Inc. to cover administrative costs. In addition, without protection as outlined below, cancellations made within 94-62 days prior to departure will be charged the amount of \$300. Within 61-34 days, 50% of total trip cost (including taxes, government fees, and airfare if booked through Dehoney Travel) will be assessed; within 33 days to day of departure/no show, entire trip cost is non-refundable. Any trip interruption due to illness, accident, family emergency, etc. is subject to 100% of the unused balance of the total tour cost. **Cancellation notice must be made in writing to Dehoney Travel. Please allow up to four weeks for refund processing.**

Royal Caribbean International (RCI) reserves the right to cancel any scheduled tour prior to departure. In the event that this should occur after final payment has been received by RCI, all payments will be refunded in full. RCI reserves the right to use alternate means of transportation when tour passenger numbers warrant such substitution and also reserves the right to change show performances when not available.



TRAVEL PROTECTION PLAN: As many U.S. health carriers do not provide benefits while outside the country and cancellation penalties can be substantial for many tours, Dehoney Travel, Inc. offers a Travel Protection Plan, TripCare, through Allianz Global Assistance. **The Option to Waive Pre-existing Condition Exclusion** requires purchase of Travel Protection within 14 days of the date on your tour deposit check or your credit card tour deposit being processed at Dehoney Travel. You may decline the Travel Protection Plan, but a signed disclaimer is required and all charges for cancellation or medical treatment/transport while traveling are your responsibility.

AIR TICKETS: Air tickets may be subject to cancellation/re-booking penalties. The cost of any cancellation or changes made once the ticket has been issued will be charged to the passenger. Special requests are subject to a deviation fee of \$100 per change.
